Saint Mary Southern Magnolia

A tree, like a mom, is the backbone and centerpiece around which all else comes to thrive. This dwarf southern magnolia has a strong form and indelible large, white, cup-shaped, fragrant flowers in the summer. Tops out at just 25 inches tall and wide.

CARE: Provide deep, nutrient-rich, acidic, well-drained soil. Water deeply and regularly during the first few growing seasons to establish an extensive root system. Reduce watering frequency once established. Although it grows best with regular moisture, it will tolerate brief dry spells. Feed in early spring before new growth emerges. Pruning time: winter.
