Kopper Kettle Itoh Peony

Just as some moms are larger than life, this peony's enormous semi-double, coppery-orange blooms turn a late spring garden into an EVENT. Itoh peonies, a cross between herbaceous and tree peonies, offer giant flowers on a vigorous plant with stronger stems.

CARE: Thrives in organically rich, slightly acidic, well-drained soils. Handle with care when transplanting; peony roots are best undisturbed. Water deeply and regularly during the first growing season to establish an extensive root system. Feed with an acid fertilizer after bloom. Keep roots cool with a thick layer of mulch. Pruning time: summer after flowering.
